

1. Our Father

- **FATHER:** God is a heavenly Father, our advocate, and He has compassion on His children.
- “A father to the fatherless, a defender of widows, is God in his holy dwelling.” Ps. 68:5
- “You are my Father, my God, the rock my Savior.”Ps. 89:26
- “As a father has compassion on his children, so the Lord has compassion on those who fear him.” Ps. 103:13
- “But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name...”
John 14:26

2. Who art in heaven

- ENTHRONED: God sovereignly sits as King, is seated on the Judge's bench in His holy temple and dwelling.
- "...the Lord is on his heavenly throne." Ps. 11:4
- "God reigns over the nations; God is seated on his holy throne." Ps. 47:8
- "Righteousness and justice are the foundation of Your throne." Ps. 89:14
- God's actions while being enthroned: speaks, hears, listens, sees, observes, laughs, scoffs

3. hallowed (holy) be thy name

- HOLY: God is above all, extraordinary, mighty, lives in His sacred home/holy mountain, and sits on His holy throne. He is spiritually perfect pure and sinless.
- “The Lord is in his holy temple, the Lord is on his heavenly throne. He observes everyone on earth; his eyes examine them.” Ps. 11:4
- “Hear my cry for mercy as I call to you for help, as I left up my hands toward your Most Holy Place.” Ps. 28:2
- “God reigns over the nations; God is seated on his holy throne.” Ps. 47:8
- “Your ways, God, are holy. What god is as great as our God?” Ps. 77:13
- “Let them praise your great and awesome name – he is holy.” Ps. 99:3
- What are God’s holy attributes? His holy name, the Holy Spirit, the Holy One
- What are God’s holy locations? The temple, His throne, His place, His mountain, His dwelling, His sanctuary

4. Thy kingdom come

- KINGDOM: the spiritual reign or authority of God.
- The rule of God or Christ in a future age.
- “The Lord has established his throne in heaven, and his kingdom rules over all.” Psa 103:19
- “so that all people may know of your mighty acts and the glorious splendor of your kingdom.” Psa 145:12
- “Your kingdom is an everlasting kingdom, and your dominion endures through all generations.” Psa 145:13

5. Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven

- COMMANDS: God counsels, orders, tells, directs, promises.
- “...Blessed are those who fear the Lord, who find great delight in his commands.” Ps.112:1
- “Direct me in the path of your commands, for there I find delight.” Ps. 119:35
- “I reach out for your commands, which I love, that I may meditate on your decrees.” Ps. 119:48
- “All your commands are trustworthy...” Ps. 119:85
- “...but your commands are boundless.” Ps. 119:96
- God’s will: wish, desire, decision, choice, decree, command.

6. Give us this day our daily bread

- GIVES: God accomplishes, provides, answers, delivers, enlightens, helps, pours down, rescues, restores, revives, saves, gives food to the hungry and to every creature, gives the desires of our hearts, and gives victories.
- Ps. 20:4 “May he give you the desire of your heart.”
- Ps. 29:11 “The Lord gives strength to his people...”
- Ps. 44:7 “...but you give us victory over our enemies.”
- Ps. 60:11 “Give us aid against the enemy,...”
- Ps. 85:12 “The Lord will indeed give what is good.”

7. And forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us

- ❖ FORGIVES (BLOTS OUT): God pardons, wipes out, covers, purges, atones, gives a clean bill of health, and removes and wipes away the stains of sin.
- ❖ “For the sake of your name, Lord, forgive my iniquity, though it is great.” Ps. 25:11
- ❖ “...blot out my transgressions.” Ps. 51:1
- ❖ “Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity.” Ps. 51:9
- ❖ “Help us, God our Saviour, for the glory of your name; deliver us and forgive our sins for your name’s sake.” Ps.79:9
- ❖ “...who forgives all your sins...” Ps. 103:3

8. Lead us not into temptation

- ❖ GUIDES (LEADS): God directs, shows, sends, takes me by the hand, leads us in righteousness and in straight paths.
- ❖ “He guides me in paths of righteousness for His name’s sake.” Ps. 23:3
- ❖ “Guide me in your truth and teach me...” Ps. 25:5
- ❖ “He guides the humble in what is right and teaches them His way.” Ps. 25:9
- ❖ “...lead me in a straight path.” Ps. 27:11
- ❖ “Send forth your light and your truth, let them guide me.” Ps. 43:3
- ❖ “...even there your hand will guide me, your right hand will hold me fast.” Ps. 139:10

9. But deliver us from evil

- ❖ DELIVERS: God is our help and saves, reaches down, handles, rescues, answers, defends; helps provide an escape, a way to allow us to slip away and avert danger.
- ❖ “The Lord is my rock, my fortress and my deliverer.” Ps. 18:2
- ❖ “...He delivered me from all my fears.” Ps.34:4
- ❖ “The angel of the Lord encamps around those who fear him, and He delivers them.” Ps. 34:7
- ❖ “...the Lord delivers them in times of trouble.” Ps.41:1
- ❖ “You have delivered me from all my troubles...” Ps. 54:7
- ❖ “...he delivered them from their distress.” Ps. 107:6

10. For thine is the Kingdom and the Power

- ❖ “...He answers him from his heavenly sanctuary with the victorious power of his right hand. Psa.20:6
- ❖ “He rules forever by his power, his eyes watch the nations...” Psa 66:7
- ❖ “Proclaim the power of God, whose majesty is over Israel, whose power is in the heavens.” Psa 68:34
- ❖ “You are the God who performs miracles; you display your power among the peoples.” Psa 77:14
- ❖ “Great is our Lord and mighty in power...” Psa 147:5

11. And the glory

- ❖ GLORIOUS: God is majestic, magnificent, abundant, has splendor, and is to be honored.
- ❖ “The heavens declare the glory of God...” Ps. 19:1
- ❖ “Splendor and majesty are before him; strength and glory are in his sanctuary.” Ps. 96:6
- ❖ “Glorious and majestic are his deeds...” Ps. 111:3
- ❖ “...so that all people may know of your mighty acts and the glorious splendor of your kingdom.” Ps. 145:12

12. Forever amen

- ❖ ETERNAL (FOREVER): God is everlasting, indefinite, unending, endless, permanently established, and dependable. God is immutable-never changing or varying; His very being is unchangeable.
- ❖ “Your throne, O God, will last forever and ever.” Ps. 45:6
- ❖ “But you, O Lord, sit enthroned forever.” Ps. 102:12
- ❖ “Your word, Lord, is eternal; it stands firm in the heavens.” Ps. 119:89
- ❖ “All your words are true; all your righteous laws are eternal.” Ps. 119:160

- ❖ Preach and Teach the Right Message
 - ❖ The truth about sin – Acts 2:23, 2:36
 - ❖ That Jesus rose from the dead – Acts 2:22-37
 - ❖ Salvation is in Christ alone – Acts 2:38-40
 - ❖ God is Sovereign – Acts 2:39

The Modern Church is supposed to...

- ❖ Be Made up of the Right People
 - ❖ It's members are saved – Acts 2:37, 2:40-41
 - ❖ Separated from the world – Acts 2:42, 2 Corinthians 5:17
John 14:15, 1 Peter 1:16, 2 Corinthians 6:14-7:1
 - ❖ Faithful to meeting – Acts 2:42, Hebrews 10:25
 - ❖ Servants to others – Acts 2:44-45, 1 John 3:17-19,
Philippians 2:4

The Modern Church is supposed to...

- ❖ Grow together
 - ❖ Worship together – Acts 2:42, Acts 2:46-47, Philippians 3:10, Psalm 135:1-3, Hebrews 13:15
 - ❖ Works as a Team – Acts 2:44-45, Ephesians 2:10, James 2:18
 - ❖ Walks together as friends - Acts 2:42, Acts 2:46, Philippians 1:27
 - ❖ Witness together as Saints – Acts 2:47, Acts 1:8, Mark 16:15, Matthew 28:19-20

- ❖ Know the Lord Personally
 - ❖ Acts 2:47, Revelation 2:1-7, Matthew 22:37-39, John 13:35
